

• SINHARAJA RAIN FOREST

Singharaja mountain range located in south-west Sri Lanka, of virgin primary tropical rainforest, of the world's highest intensity of biodiversity of rare endemic flora (217 varieties of trees) & fauna (830 endemic species). The majority of them are considered as Sri Lanka's endemic species of mammals, butterflies, as well as many kinds of insects, reptile and rare amphibians.



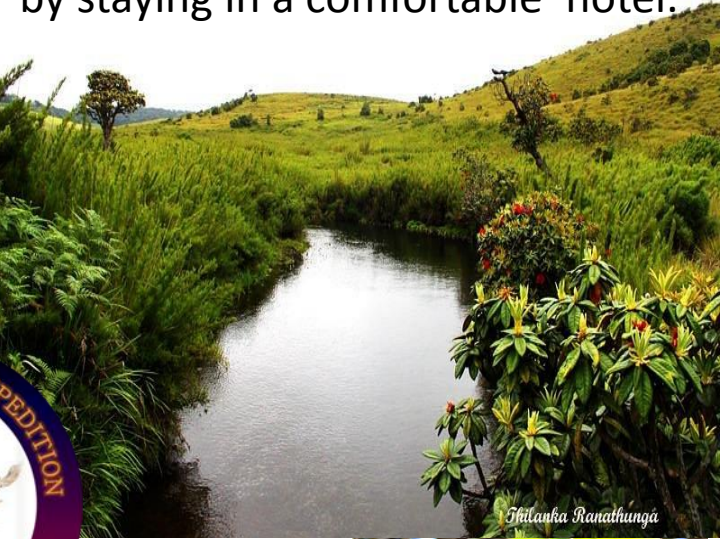
A study of full 3 days, is recommended by staying in comfortable jungle cabanas



• HORTON PLAIN

It is located at an elevation of 2,100–2,300 m (6,900–7,500 ft) and encompasses mountain grassland of 3,160 hectares and cloud forest rich in biodiversity and many endemic flora and fauna species.

Full two day's study is suggested by staying in a comfortable hotel.

• WASGAMUWA NATIONAL PARK

Wasgamuwa National Park spanning 36,900 hectares situated in the Matale / Polonnaruwa district, 225 km away from the City of Colombo. A vast variety of wild life in the forest & the aquatic ecosystem of birds, creatures & animals(of some dangerous sorts) are intensified within a close proximity as the specialty in Wasgamuwa. Full two day's study stay is recommended in jungle cabanas or comfortable forest lodgings
